AGREEMENT AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

This Agreement is made between Melbourne Jeep Owners Club Inc, the National Jeep Jamboree Victoria 2010 Committee and its officials (the Organiser) and either (1) the applicant/s named on this application form who are 18 years or over, OR (2) the parent or parents named on this application form where the applicant/s also named on this application form are under the age of 18 years (the contracting parties) in relation to attendance at the National Jeep Jamboree Victoria 2010 (the Event).

Privacy

The contracting parties acknowledge and agree that the personal information contained in this Agreement may be supplied to Organisers, Partners, and Sponsors of the Event for marketing purposes.

Indemnity and Waiver

- A. In consideration of the individual(s) named on this application form being accepted as a participant in the Event, the contracting parties hereby agree with the Organiser that:
1. The Organiser shall have no liability whatsoever in negligence, breach of contract, breach of statute or statutory duty to the applicants, the parents or any dependant thereof or their legal representative for personal injury or death suffered by the applicants or the parents arising in any way whatsoever from the supply by the Organiser of recreational services associated with the Event.
 2. The contracting parties acknowledge that the recreational activities on offer at the Event are associated with many inherent risks as a result of which personal injuries (and sometimes death) are consequences. The contracting parties hereby FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY ASSUME AND ACCEPT all risk of personal injury or death in any way whatsoever arising from the recreational activities offered at the Event; and agree to inform themselves and assess all the dangers, hazards and risks of participating in their chosen form of conduct. Further the contracting parties and any dependant thereof and their legal representative release the Organiser and waive all liability and claims with respect to the supply of recreational services to the applicants and the applicants' participation in the Event.
 3. The contracting parties hereby jointly and severally agree to FULLY INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS the Organiser from all claims, demands, actions and suits which may at any time hereafter be brought by or on behalf of the applicants, the parents or any other person against the Organiser for personal injury or death suffered by the applicants, the parents, or by any other person or caused by the applicants to any other person in any way whatsoever arising out of the participation in the Event.
 4. The contracting parties acknowledge that this Agreement:
 - a. is an agreement for the supply of recreational services at the Event,
 - b. is governed by the laws of the State of Victoria and the Commonwealth of Australia and agree that the Courts of the State of Victoria shall have exclusive jurisdiction, and
 - c. constitutes the entire agreement between the contracting parties and the Organiser and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible against the contracting parties and in favour of the Organiser.

Other Terms

- B. In consideration of the applicant(s) named on this application form being considered as a participant in the Event, the contracting parties hereby also agree with the Organiser that:
1. The applicants will (and the parents will procure that the applicants will) abide by the Organiser's Conditions of Entry, as detailed below. The Organiser may, upon an individual's failure to comply with any Condition of Entry, cancel that individual's registration, at which time the individual will be required to leave the Event site.
 2. The Organiser has the right in its absolute discretion to accept or refuse an application. If the application is rejected, the applicant will be refunded all fees paid by or on behalf of the applicant to the Organiser in respect of its event.
 3. Once the applicants are accepted or provisionally accepted to the Event, the deposit paid and any other moneys paid by or on behalf of the applicants under this agreement shall be refundable to the extent detailed on the application form. This Clause applies to all circumstances, including an applicant withdrawing from an event as a result of illness or injury.

Conditions of Entry

1. The Event will consist of on-road and off-road driving and other recreational events. Each driver will receive a list of events and their rules after receipt by the Organiser of the Registration Form and the Jamboree Fees, or in the Jamboree Kit on arrival at the Jamboree Site. Each applicant agrees to abide by the rules of each and every event.
2. Members of the Organiser, or persons delegated by the Organiser, will conduct all events, and any directives issued by them are to be complied with.
3. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse any entry, disqualify any entrant or vehicle, or cancel any event it deems necessary.
4. The decision or direction of the Organiser or allocated Steward or Trip Leader in respect to any event will be final and binding.
5. Receipt of a completed application form is confirmation by each applicant that his/her vehicle is registered and carrying a minimum of Third Party insurance, is in good roadworthy mechanical condition, and is able to be engaged in high and low range four wheel drive.
6. Unregistered or display vehicles may be transported by truck or trailer to the Event, but must not be driven on or off the Event site. Please carry proof of vehicle registration and insurance as it may be requested.
7. All drivers must hold a current valid driver's licence.
8. All drivers and passengers must be properly restrained in vehicles during all trips and events.
9. The use of Agricultural type tyres, chains and other traction aids are subject to the express permission of the Organiser.
10. No occupants of any vehicle are permitted to consume alcohol during any trip or event.
11. All drivers agree to abide by Victoria's blood alcohol laws whilst participating in any driving or recreational event associated with the Event.
12. Designated event areas which display a closed sign are not to be entered or used until declared open by the designated Steward.
13. Campfires will only be permitted with the express permission of the Organiser. The organiser will determine the location of campfires.
14. There will be a 5kph speed limit imposed on the Jamboree site except for the designated event areas.
15. Trade or commercial sales are only permitted at the allocated Trade Alley sites and with the agreement of the Organiser's.
16. Pets, firearms, fireworks and motor bikes are prohibited on the Event site, and are prohibited on any trip or recreational event.
17. Generators must not be operated between the times of 8.00pm and 7.00am.
18. Offensive, sexist or racist language is prohibited.
19. Fighting, bullying or any other form of aggressive behaviour is prohibited.
20. All participants will respect others' right to privacy.
21. Behaving in a manner which is potentially dangerous to self and others is prohibited.
22. Behaving in a manner which damages or vandalises the property of others or the environment is prohibited.
